Around the perimeter from top left runs a long-lived tag-line (2,8,5,2,7,4). Clues are listed in alphabetical order of their solutions. Put the answers where they will fit.

Title refers to the pub in Ambridge, The Bull. Perimeter is The Archers' sub-title: AN EVERYDAY STORY OF COUNTRY FOLK. I don't think it's still used since the soap became so brattish and middle class.
